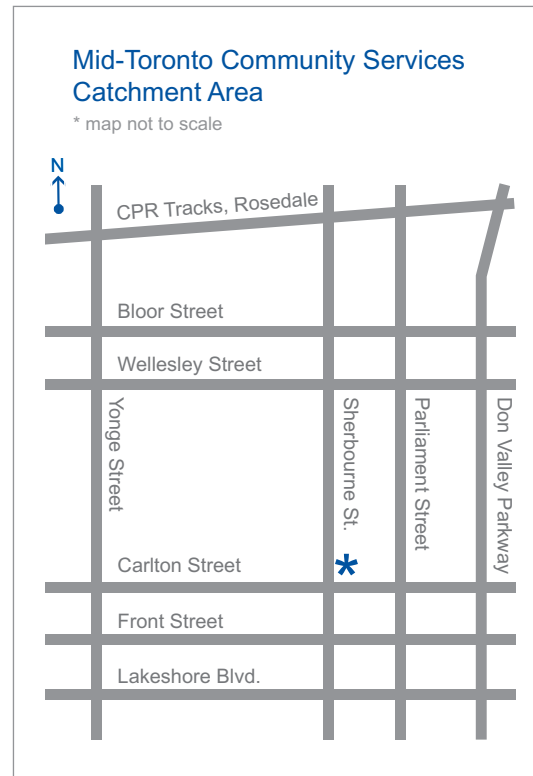


How do I get Started? Contact Information

Critical Housing Case Management Program

Helping seniors and adults with disabilities or illness to access and maintain appropriate, safe and affordable housing



Did you know that from 2000-2002, 97% of all new housing built in the city was for ownership?

Did you know that prior to 2003, the city's vacancy rates were below 2.5% for the previous 30 years?

Through individual case management and planning, the Critical Housing Case Management Program offers holistic help to some of the most vulnerable and marginalized individuals in the community who are under-housed, homeless or facing eviction.

Eligibility

- Adults with disabilities include those who suffer from:
 - Physical disabilities
 - Mental health issues or substance addictions
- Seniors include anyone over 55 years of age

Referrals

Referrals are accepted from family, friends, doctors, community care access centres, health care professionals and social workers. Self referrals are also permitted.

- Assistance in managing discrimination and racism
- Mediation, negotiation & conflict resolution with landlords, social housing and other institutions
